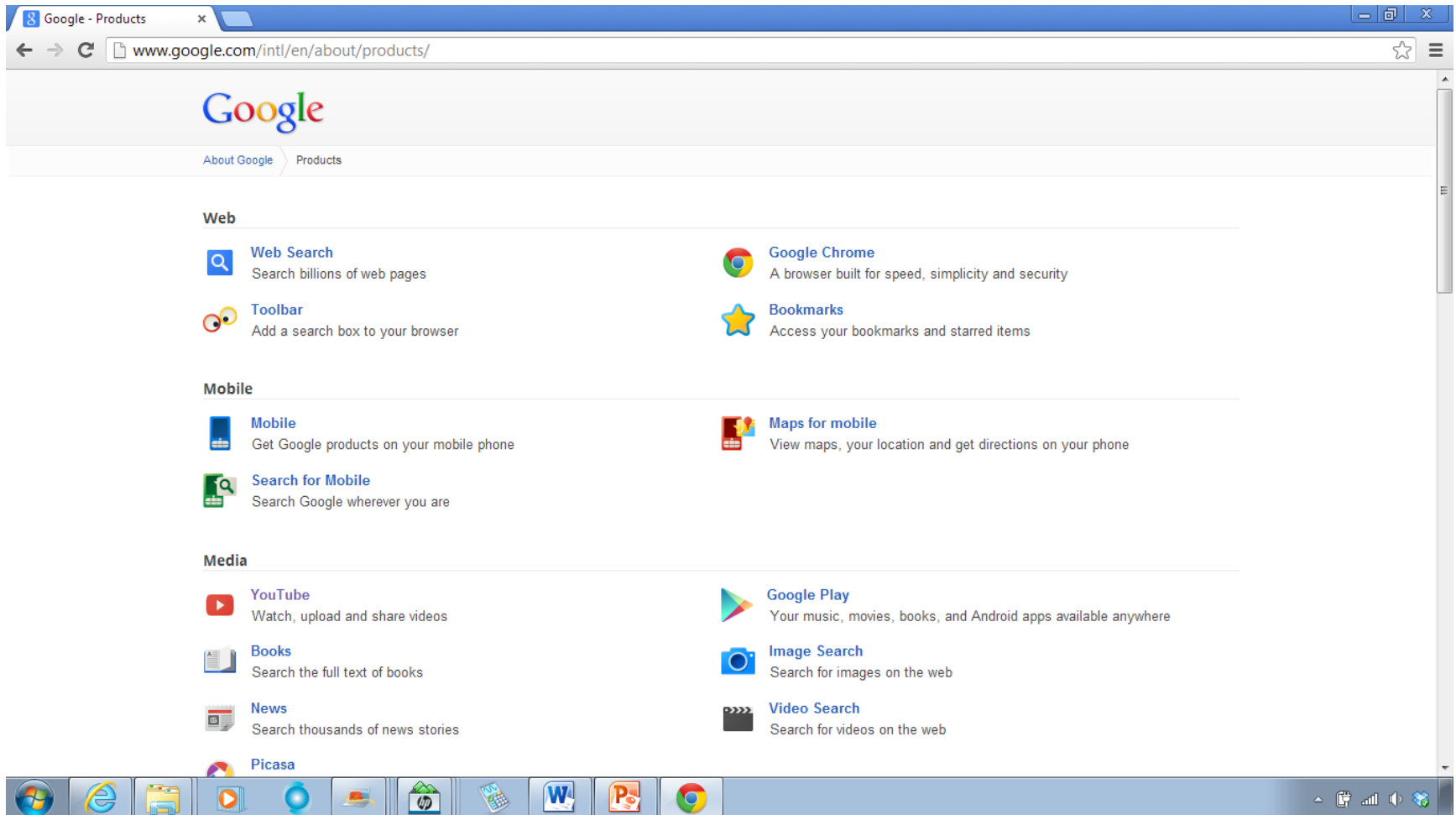

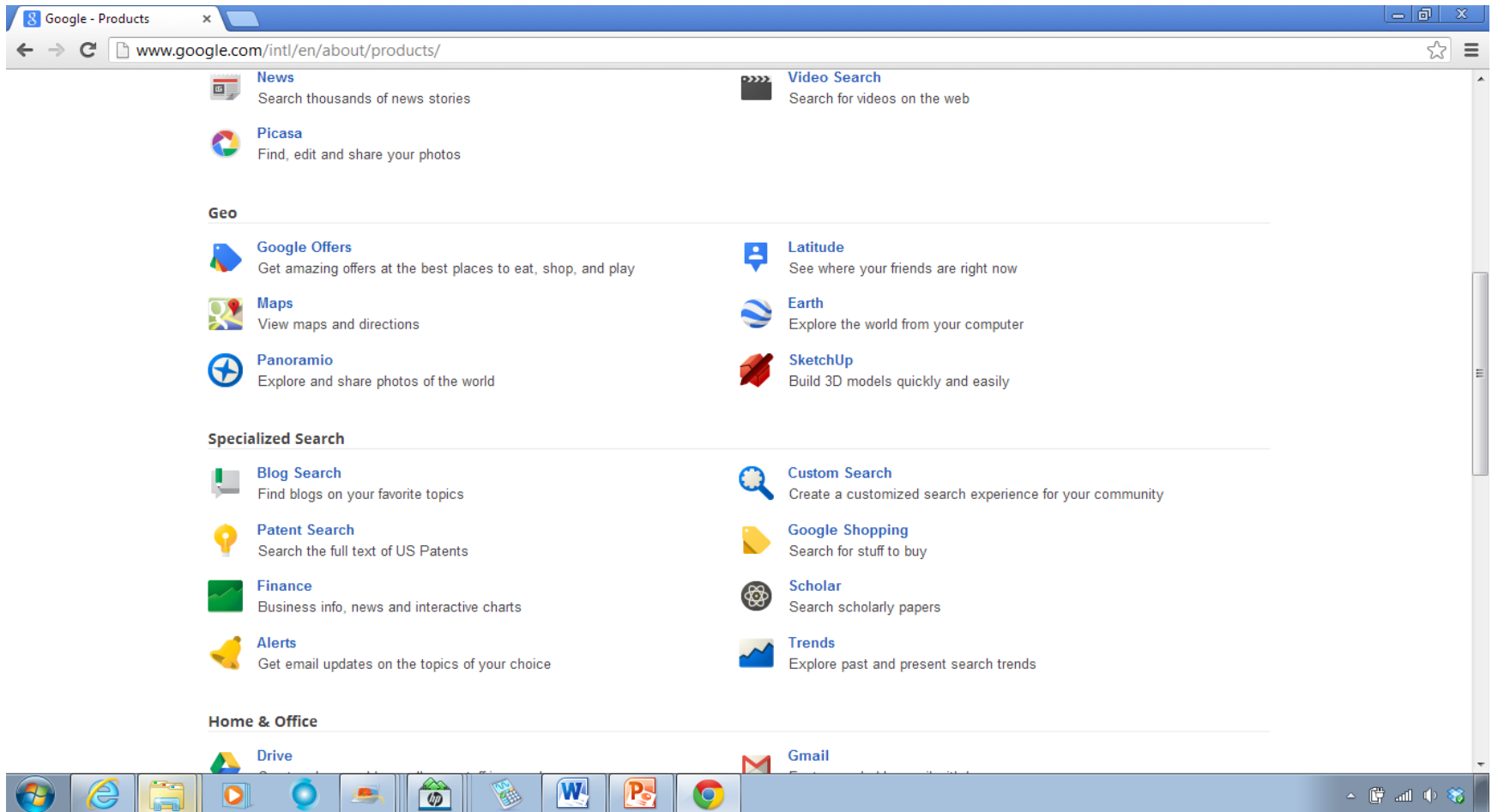

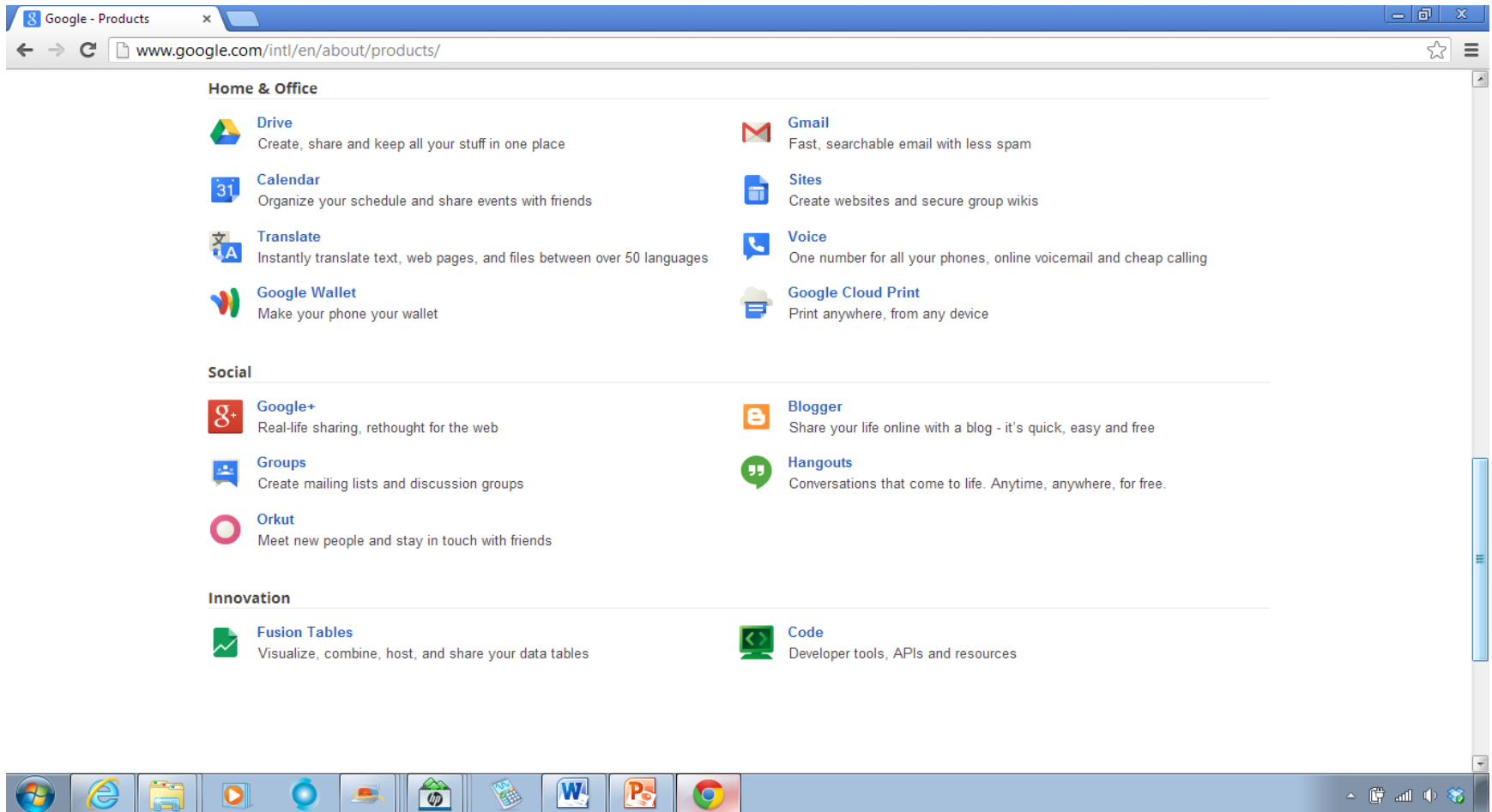

Gmail

- ❖ In order to use most Google products and services, a
- ❖ **Gmail account is required.** Gmail account is free
 - So, let's create an account if you do not have one
 - The direct link is: [gmail.google.com](https://mail.google.com)
- ❑ Gmail is used for:
 - Sending email messages
 - Chat with your students
 - Video calls to your students via the Hangouts in Gmail

Google Groups

- The direct link is groups.google.com
- ❑ Google Groups is used to:
 - Communicate with your entire class students as a group. It makes it easier to send the same message to a group of people using just one email address, rather than the different email addresses of the people in that group.
 - Engage you and your students in discussions on a class project or topic
 - Easily create and manage learning teams
 - Organize meetings, and conferences with your group

Google Drive

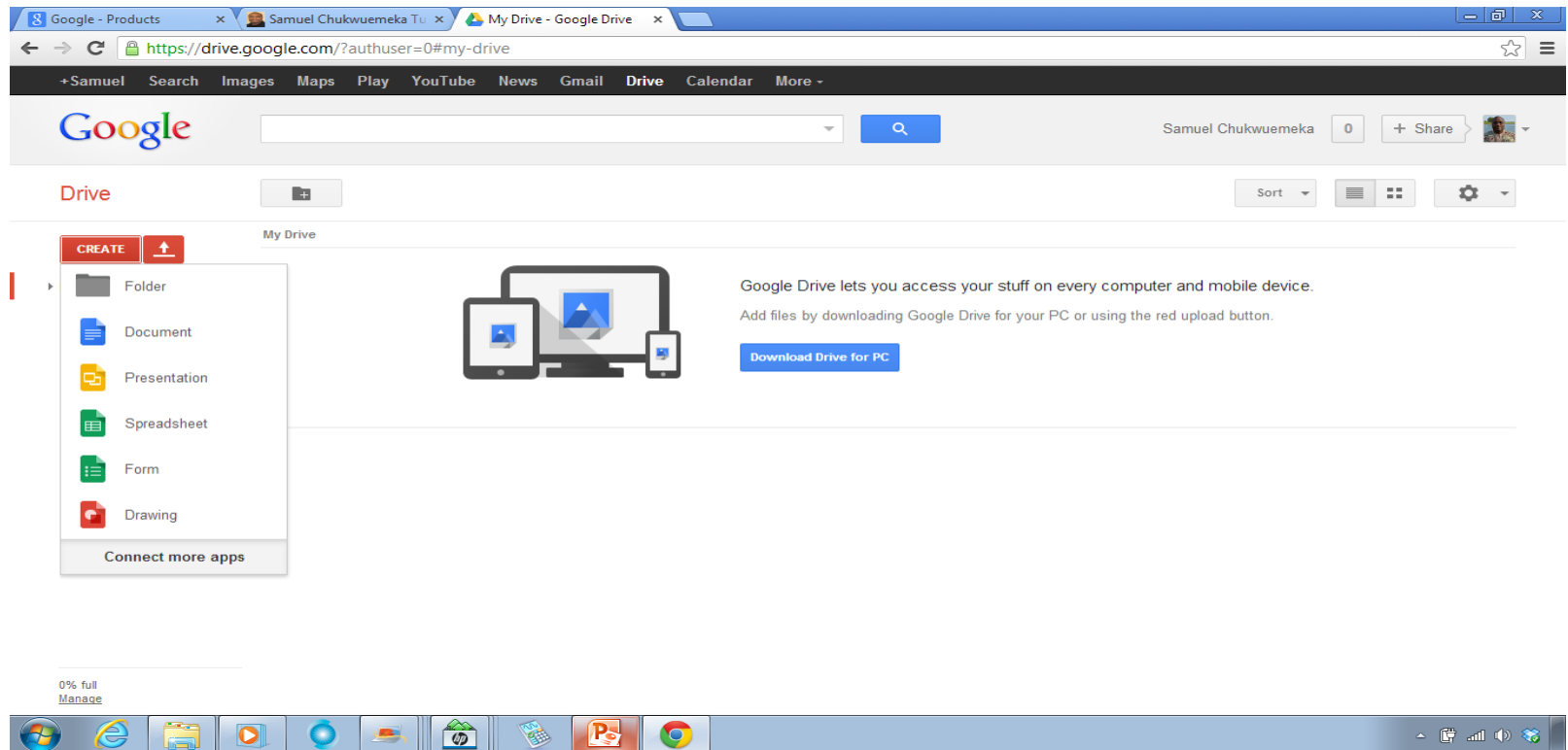
- The direct link is drive.google.com
- ❑ Google Drive enables one to:
 - Store photos, videos, documents, files, and folders
 - Share photos, videos, documents, and files to collaborators
 - Send large file attachments via email
 - Create and share Google docs, slides/presentations, forms, spreadsheets, and drawings.
 - Get up to 15GB of storage free.
 - Google Drive is similar to Dropbox – the file sharing software application. Can you tell me the difference?

Google Docs

- The direct link is docs.google.com
- Google Docs enables one to create, share, manage, and collaborate on the web with:
- Documents (similar to Microsoft Office Word)
- Spreadsheets (similar to Microsoft Office Excel)
- Presentations (similar to Microsoft Office PowerPoint)
- Forms
- Drawings

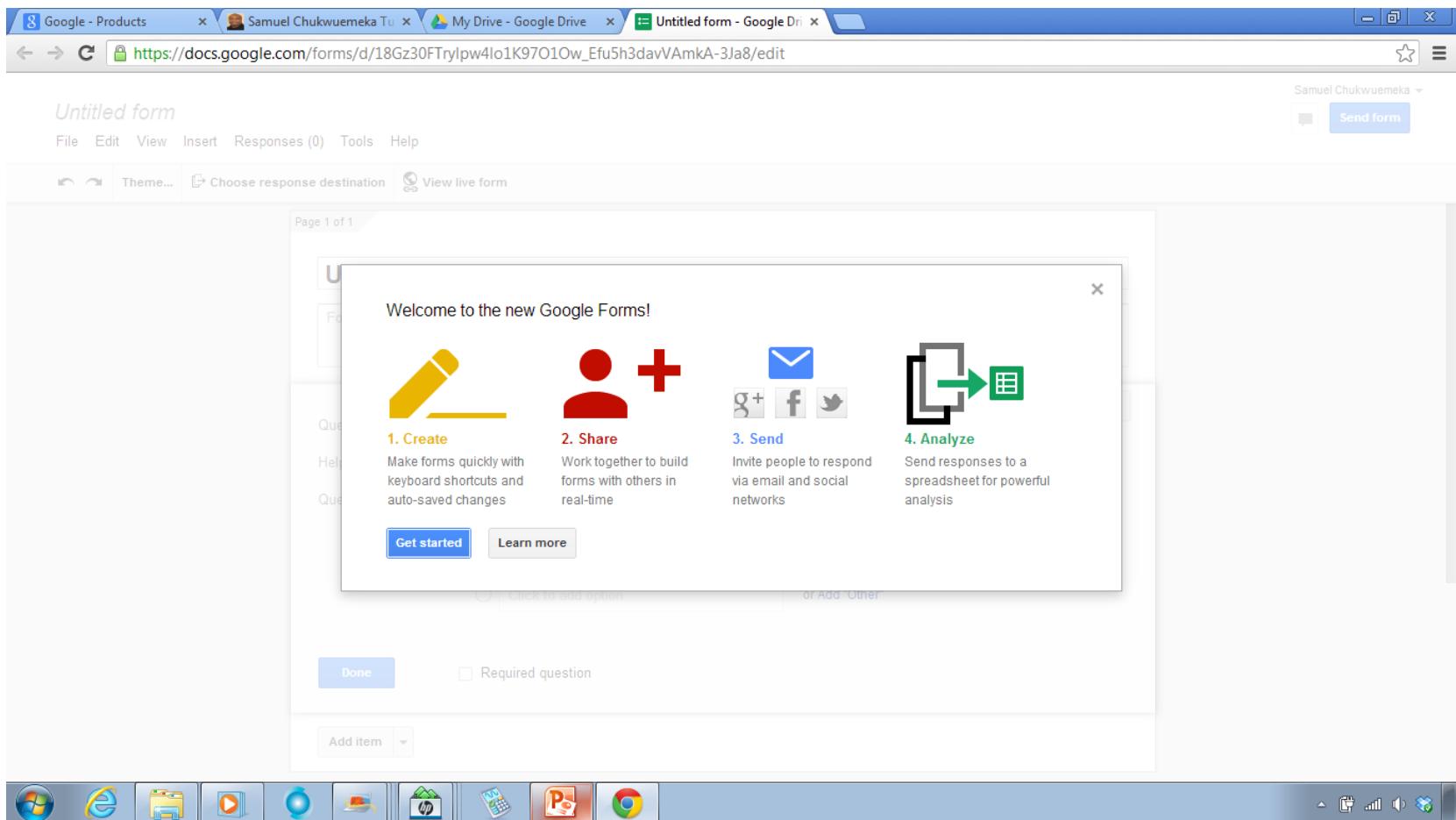

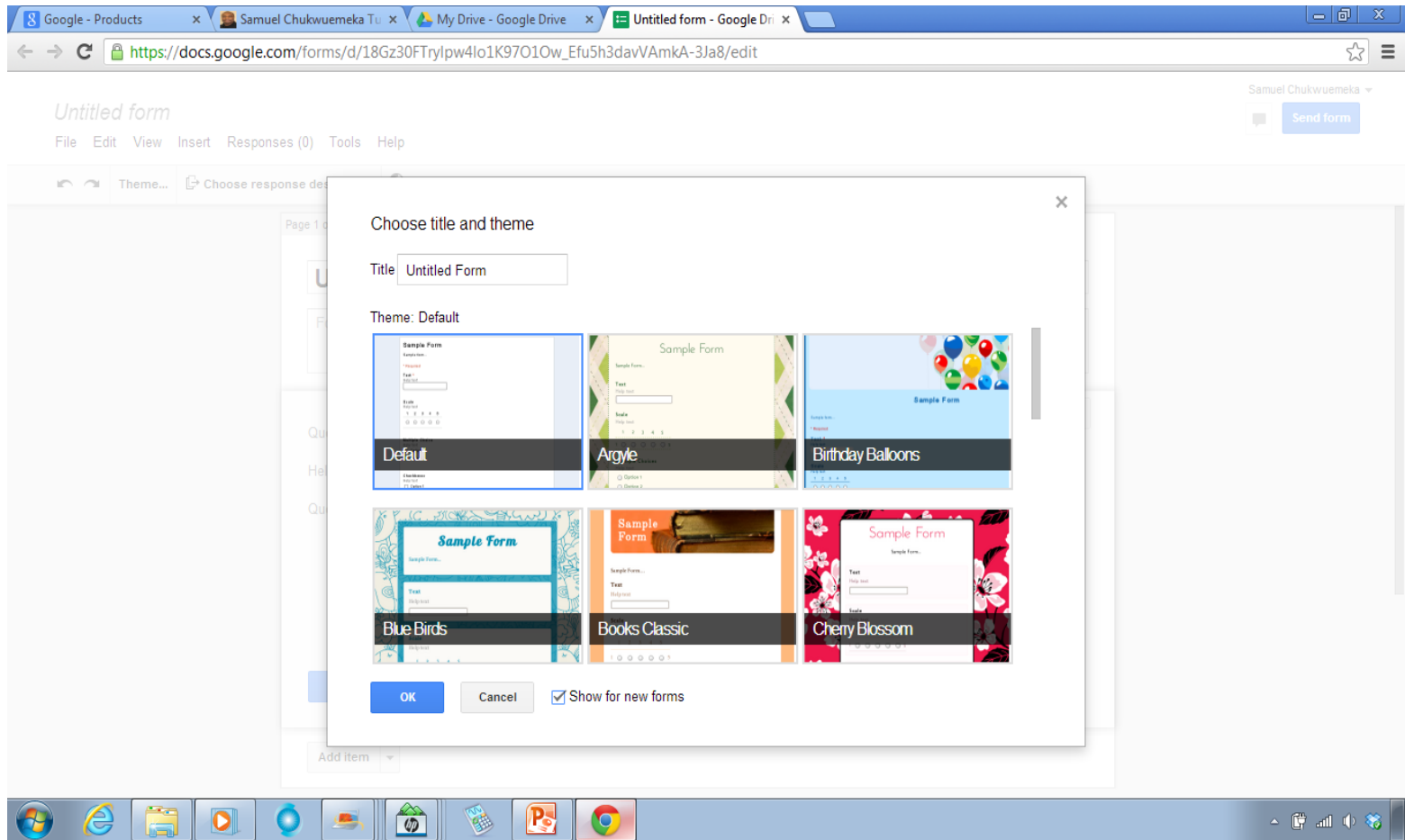

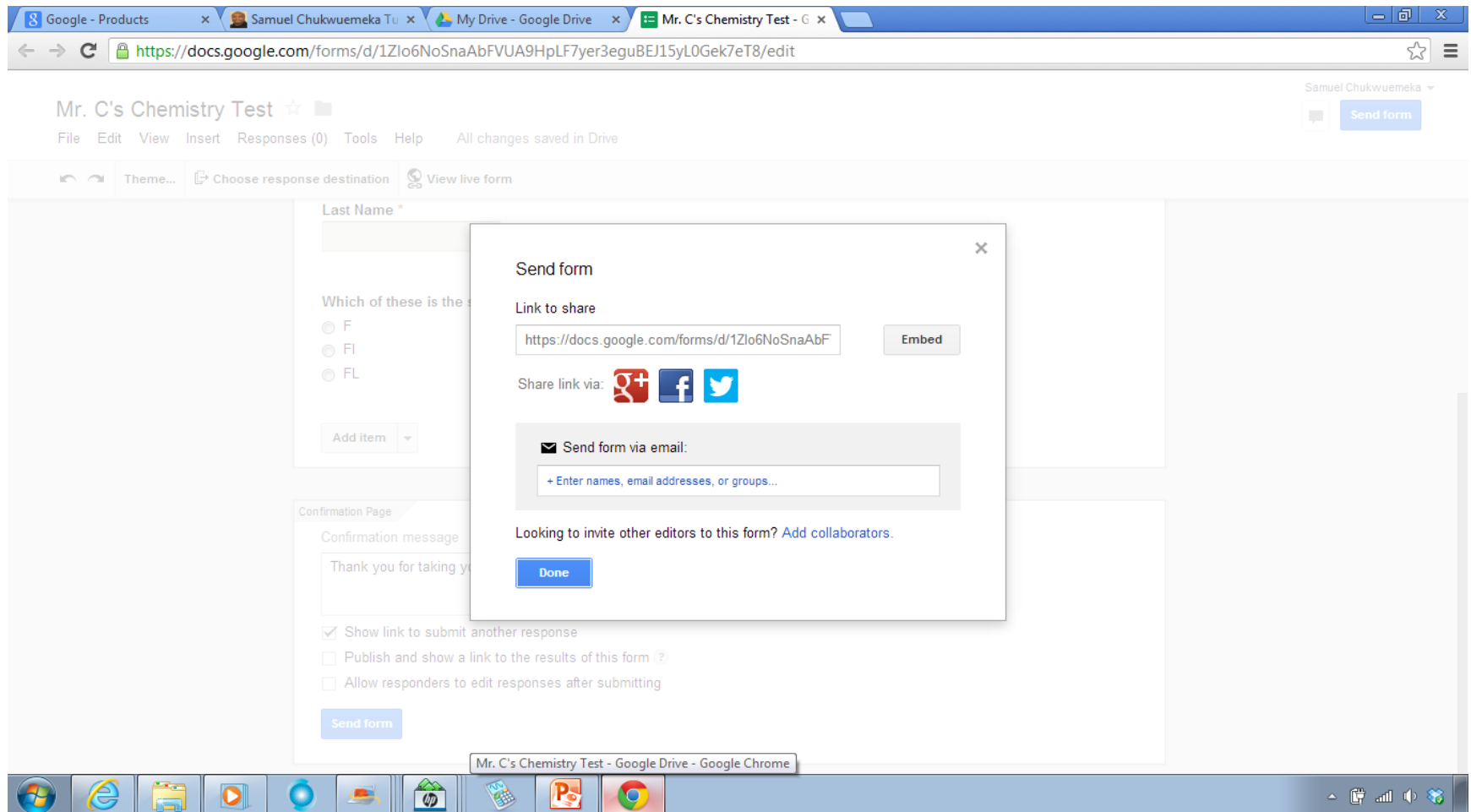

Mr. C's Chemistry Test - Google Drive - Google Chrome

Do not Worry.

- Your test is automatically saved in the Google Drive as you type. Look at the top of your form for a message that reads “All changes saved”.
- You can create multiple choice, text, paragraph text, checkboxes, drop-down list, among others, including a mixture of all of them.
- You can explore a lot of the options available including providing a hint or help text to your questions, duplicating your test, adding more test items, publishing a link to the responses, allowing your students to edit responses after submitting, among others.

You Have the Option of:

Click “Done” and Choose a Response Destination

- You have the option of:
- Storing your responses in a spreadsheet (by default). In that case, it is better to create a new spreadsheet OR
- Storing your responses in forms. In that case, click “Keep responses only in Forms”. If you check this option, then, you will need to download the responses as “Comma Separated Values”. This option is good if the test responses will exceed 400,000 responses.
- Otherwise, choose the “New spreadsheet” option.
- Click “Create”
- It sets up the spreadsheet under the heading “View responses”

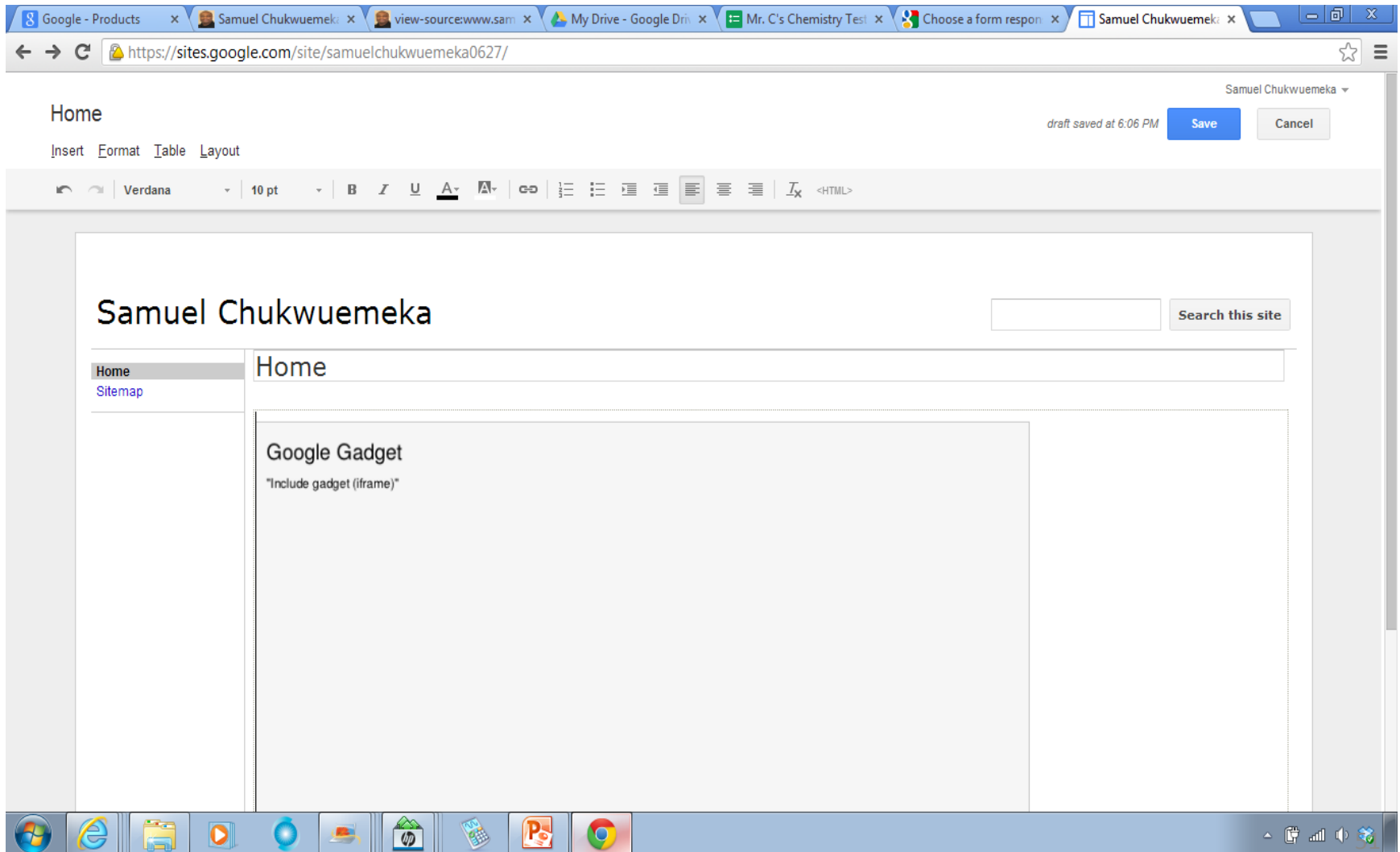
